

THE SEASON OF ADVENT begins on Sunday 2nd December. It was once a season of fasting, the pre-Christmas equivalent to Lent. It still is, within the Church, a time of reflection, as we prepare of one of the great Christian festivals – Christmas, or the Feast of the Incarnation (literally, God made flesh). These days it is difficult not to be rushed along by commercial pressure into beginning to celebrate Christmas so early, that by 24th December we are suffering from Christmas fatigue!

We have managed to maintain a Communion Service on each of the four Sundays of Advent, so come along, and as the candles are lit on the Advent Ring, journey with the prophets, Mary, John the Baptist and all the people of God, and be reminded of the excitement of expecting *God with us – Immanuel*.

EXPLORING OUR CHRISTIAN FAITH:

What does it mean to be a Christian today? Is there a God? What do Christians really believe? How does prayer work? If those are questions that you would like to explore, then this is the course for you!

Exploring our Christian faith is a 12 week for anyone who wants to find out more about living the Christian life, or maybe take the step of commitment which is known as Confirmation.

Confirmation is one of the special times that the Church describes as a 'sacrament' – a sacred moment, when God does something special in our lives. In Confirmation we confirm that the power of the Holy Spirit is at work, to guide us in our lives as Christian people, and we confirm the statements of faith that

were made on our behalf at our Baptism. The lower age limit for Confirmation is 10 years old. There is no upper limit!
